

**PROVO CITY ENERGY DEPARTMENT
ELECTRIC SERVICE SCHEDULE**

**HIGHWAY LIGHTING AND
TRAFFIC SIGNAL SERVICE
NO. 8**

AVAILABILITY

This schedule is available at any point on the Energy Department electric system where facilities of adequate capacity and standard lighting and signal voltage levels are available.

APPLICATION

This schedule is for service required for year-round automatically controlled dusk-to-dawn lighting of public streets, highways, roads, alleys, thoroughfares, or other publicly dedicated rights-of-way used for the movement of vehicular traffic. This service is provided to municipalities or agencies of municipal, county, state, or federal governments, for traffic and other signal system service, and for metered outdoor nighttime lighting service, and owned by the customer.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Service under this schedule shall be single-phase, 60 Hertz, alternating current at the Energy Department’s available standard distribution voltage. Standby or resale service is not permitted.

MONTHLY RATE

SPECIFICATIONS AND SERVICE

Fixtures and supports will follow Energy Department specifications. Service by the Energy Department includes energy supplied from the Energy Department’s overhead circuits.

The Energy Department reserves the right to enter the customer’s premises, without being subject to trespass, at all reasonable times for the purpose of inspecting, maintaining, and installing or removing equipment or facilities. The customer may be requested to reimburse the Energy Department for the cost of any maintenance work required due to vandalism.

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48 **LIMITATION OF SERVICE**

49 Lights to be served under this schedule shall be located, in the opinion of the Energy
50 Department, where they are easily and economically accessible to the equipment and
51 personnel required for construction and maintenance. Steel poles may only be located
52 where they are easily accessible to an Energy Department bucket truck.

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54 The Energy Department, while always exercising reasonable diligence to furnish service,
55 does not guarantee continuous lighting and will not be liable for damages resulting
56 from any interruption, deficiency, or failure of service. The Energy Department also
57 reserves the right to interrupt service at any time for necessary repairs to lines and
58 equipment or for system protection. The customer will assume responsibility for
59 keeping trees, shrubs and other plants clear of the lighting fixture and the wires serving
60 the lighting fixture.

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62 **CHARGES FOR UNDERGROUND SERVICE**

63 If underground service is requested by a customer, he will reimburse the Energy
64 Department for the total cost differential between a standard overhead configuration
65 and the requested underground configuration. Customer may also pay actual cost for
66 any install.

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68 **TAX ADJUSTMENTS**

69 The amount computed at the above monthly rate shall be subject to taxes, assessments
70 and surcharges imposed by Provo City or any governmental authority authorized to levy
71 said taxes, assessments, or surcharges.

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73 **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

74 Service under this schedule will be in accordance with the Energy Department's electric
75 service standards and policies and terms and conditions set forth by the Department's
76 standard application requirements and Provo City Ordinances, including any future
77 additions or amendments.

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
